Indonesia:

The internal process to implement TFA is still ongoing. On 8th December 2016, the draft Bill of Ratification of the "Protocol Amending the Marrakesh Agreement Establishing World Trade Organization" is still under discussion for Parliamentary approval; Discussion between the Government and Parliament has not pointed to clarity regarding the indicative date of ratification.

Papua New Guinea:

Approval given by National Executive Council (NEC) to be tabled in Parliament for ratification.
