  - Australia will be the first economy to transition to the Mobile Application from March 2021.

- The Group discussed the rollout to Online Lodgement for economies.
- Indonesia provided a presentation on the their APEC funded project on Capacity Building Workshop on Improving the Utilization of APEC Business Travel Card they are hosting in 2021.
- The Group further discussed changes post COVID-19 and how IATA could assist in COVID-19 recovery efforts.
- New Zealand, as APEC host for 2021 advised the Group of their intentions to host all meetings virtually in 2021, and dates and more information would be provided in due course.
